The Principals have been frequently representing the Society that the amounts for sweeping sanitation contracts, part time electrician, staff nurse / health supervisor and part time teachers in APSWR Institutions, were fixed long back, and no persons are coming forward for the existing rates.

The Issue was placed in the 54th Board of Governors meeting held on 29.12.2009 under agenda item no 18 and it was agreed for enhancement of charges payable to sweeping sanitation contracts, part time electrician, staff nurse / health supervisor and part time teachers in APSWR Institutions and also to modify / amend the qualifications of the post of Staff Nurse / Health Supervisors as follows :

I. ENHANCEMENT OF SWEEPING AND SANITATION CHARGES :

1) Existing – Through an outsourcing agency / Labour contract society

II. ENHANCEMENT OF REMUNERATION TO THE PART TIME ELECTRICIANS

It was agreed to enhance the charges payable to the part time electricians [on piece meal basis] in APSWR Institutions from Rs.1,000/- to Rs.2,000/- P.m.

III. ENHANCEMENT OF REMUNERATION TO THE STAFF NURSE / HEALTH SUPERVISOR AND REVISION OF QUALIFICATIONS.

The Board of Governors modified the qualifications for recruitment of Staff Nurse / Health Supervisors as follows :

Remuneration :-

It is decided to pay the following remuneration to the Staff Nurse / Health Supervisor working on Contract / Part time basis as follows :

GNM	5,500-00	5,000-00

The Board agreed to designate the Health Supervisors with Medical Graduation as Medical Officers

IV. Enhancement of remuneration to the part time JL / Teacher.

The Board agreed to enhance the remuneration to the part time teachers from Rs.50 to Rs.75/- per hour to the school section and from Rs.80/- to Rs.100/- per hour to the college section not exceeding the total amount of Rs.5,000/- per month.

These orders will come into force with immediate effect.

Therefore all the Principals are instructed to take necessary action accordingly.
